## 12/U Club League

### 1. Objects:

- To encourage club swimmers of “lesser” current ability to swim competitively.
- To give opportunity to parents and swimming supporters to be introduced to poolside official duties.
- To foster a healthy competitive environment between clubs in the Wellington region.

### 2. Period of Competition

- Competition to be swum at four meets over a total period not exceeding four calendar months.

### 3. Format

- Organisation to be kept as simple as possible.
- Swimming is on a CLUB basis.
- Each meet to be of short duration (approx. 1.5 hours).
- League is to function with swimmers selected by clubs on ability levels within the “Team selection “ guidelines set out below.

### 4. Team Selection

- Open to those swimmers who did not meet the New Zealand Junior National qualifying time during the qualifying period.
- A team shall consist of a maximum of twelve swimmers. No change in team personnel is allowed for the duration of the competition.
- There may not be more than six 11/12 year olds with a maximum of 3 12year olds in the one team.
- All swimmers shall be 12 years of age or under on the first meet of the series.
- A team member shall compete in a maximum of 3 events (including relays) at each meet.
- Race secretaries are to submit swimmers registration numbers, 50m and relevant 100m best times with Team Registration sheets.

## 5. Events

- The events of the competition shall be:

1.	4 x 25m	Breast Relay
2.	25m	Backstroke
3.	25m	Butterfly
4.	25m	Breaststroke
5.	25m	Freestyle
6.	4 x 25m	Backstroke Relay
7.	100m	Freestyle
8.	4 x 25m	Medley Relay
9.	50m	Backstroke
10.	50m	Butterfly
11.	50m	Breaststroke
12.	50m	Freestyle
13.	100m	Individual Medley
14.	4 x 25m	Freestyle Relay

## 6. Scoring

- Points shall be awarded on a descending scale of 12 e.g. 1st place 12 points. 2nd place 11 points etc.

## 7. Poolside Personnel

Clubs will be required to provide for each team entered:

- Team manager

The following positions will be rostered by the meet organiser.

- 3 time keepers (not necessarily qualified) and one chief timekeeper (who is qualified).
- Recorder
- A "runner"
- rope steward
- marshal
- personnel to help set up or dismantle pool gear.

Club League is run as a learning experience for swimmers and officials. Qualified officials will be officiating and are willing to help train new people.

- 8. Meet to be swum under SNZ rules.

All participating clubs agree to accept the spirit and the rules of the meet in the interests of fostering developing swimmers.

## **9. Disqualification/ Dispensation**

Any team who incurs one or more of the following will be deemed disqualified and will forfeit all points for the meet.

- Has a swimmer who is not registered as a team member or does not qualify in terms of the above conditions.
- Fails to provide the required number of officials.

### **Note:**

The meet controller shall have the power to grant dispensation from any of the league requirements PROVIDED that NO DISPENSATION shall be granted AFTER THE EVENT and the power to grant dispensation shall be used sparingly.

Any request for dispensation shall be submitted to the Meet Controller.
