How to get there

From the South – go through Foxton and take the first road on the right (Motuiti Road) after leaving Foxton. The ride base is along this road on your left.

Distances & Entry fees

<u>Class</u>	<u>Distance</u>	<u>Entry fee</u>	<u>Qualification criteria</u>
Non-Championship	20km	\$25	None other than horses must be 4 years or over.
Novice Championship	25km	\$30	Combination must have qualified in 2 x Novice classes in the current ride season. Horses must be 5 years or over.
Marton Brick & Tile Championship	30km	\$30	Combination must have qualified in 2 x Marton Brick & Tile classes in the current ride season. Horses must be 5 years or over.
Intermediate Championship	40km	\$30	Combination must have qualified in 2 x Intermediate classes in the current ride season. Horses must be 5 years or over.
Open Championship	40km	\$30	Combination must have qualified in 2 x Open classes in the current ride season. Horses must be 5 years or over.

Vetting from 7.30am on the day. Ride briefing at 8.15am.

All classes other than non-championship must be pre-entered and paid for by Friday, 19th March 2010. Riders in the non-championship may pre-enter or enter on the day after 7.30am.
