**Entry Fees:** \$7 per class. Maximum of three tests per horse

**Show Levy:** \$10 first horse/\$5 for each extra horse. Solway Dressage Members \$5 for each horse

**Yard Fees:** Covered yards \$15/Uncovered yards \$10 each

**Prizes:** Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> place getters in classes 1 – 14. No ribbons awarded to Class 15

## Conditions of Entry:

1. This is a non-graded competition. ESNZ horse or rider registration is not required.
2. Jackets and plaiting not required. Tidy dress, approved safety helmet and boots to be worn.
3. Post entries to Ann Webster, 344 Kahutara Road, RD 1, Featherston, 5771. Cheques are payable to Solway Dressage. Entries must be paid in full by the closing date.
4. No email or phone entries accepted. Late entries will not be accepted.
5. Entries are to be made on the Solway Dressage Ribbon Day Entry Form on the website [www.solwaydressage.com](http://www.solwaydressage.com)
6. The draw will be available on the website by 23 February 2012.

8. Fees will be refunded less 50% of Entry Fees only if a Doctor or Vet certificate is provided within 7 days of the show.
9. If weather conditions are doubtful, the responsibility is on the competitor to check if the Ribbon Day will be held. Cancellation or postponement will be advertised on the website where possible.
10. Riders aged under 12 years will be judged separately if sufficient entries are received. Please indicate on the entry form if the rider is under 12 years.
11. Local riders must include a Rider Assistance Form with their entry. Rider Assistance Forms can be downloaded from our website.
12. Horses with dressage grading points are to enter the level required as if entering a graded competition. The Committee may approve exceptions where riders have not earned dressage points higher than Level Two. Approval must be sought through the Event Secretary prior to entries closing.
13. Training classes are for inexperienced horses and/or riders in all disciplines. The Committee has the right to transfer riders to a higher level if appropriate.
14. Masterton A&P Society does not allow dogs on Solway Showground. Please respect this rule.
15. Solway Dressage accepts no liability for loss, damage or injury to spectators, competitors, horses/ponies or their property.
