FEES

Class Entry Fee – per table above; **Show Levy** - \$15/horse/day

Equine Accommodation - Day yards \$5/day; Overnight yards \$10/night and day, Exceptional stabling \$20/night and day (please state nights required on entry form)

Human Accommodation – Limited Bunk Room accommodation (provide your own bedding) available \$15/person. If camping or overnighing in your truck or float on the grounds, please add a \$5/person/night fee (to a maximum of \$15/truck/float/tent.) Showers and toilets provided.

PRACTICE DAYS

You may ride in the arenas on the day before the show for \$10/horse – includes use of all dressage arenas (Far Arena, Café Arena and Indoor Arena). Each day starts at 9am and concludes at 5pm
Pay in Payments Box (at stable entry) on the day, no need to book.

CONDITIONS

1. **This series is run under ESNZ rules** and these will be enforced. Tielcey Park disclaims all liability in accordance with Article 163 ESNZ general rule.
2. **Sponsors:** Please support our sponsors – without them we would have no shows at Tielcey Park.
3. **We need writers:** Show levy refunded for half day writing – contact the office by email or phone before the show to nominate writers.
4. **Alteration, Accidents & Administration:** Tielcey Park reserves the right to alter or cancel the programme if necessary. Riders ride at their own risk. Tielcey Park takes no responsibility for any accidents. The event manager has the authority to evict and eliminate anyone whom they deem to be acting in an unacceptable manner. Any bounced or stopped cheques will incur a \$20 admin fee.
5. **Late Entries** – entries close strictly on closing date. Late entries may be accepted and will incur a \$5 late fee per horse. Please phone 021 741 772 to enquire about late entries.
6. **Training Classes** – If you or your horse are not registered with ESNZ, you may enter the Training classes only. No additional charges apply – please enter on the official entry form, on our website or ESNZ site
7. **Pony Riders** 17 years and under – if four or more entries in a class, a separate pony class will be added to the show. Points gained from these classes will be allocated to a Pony Series and also to their age group series (if entered). Pony series champions and reserves will receive a sash.
8. **Series points** will be awarded to the first ten placings in each class, 10 points for 1st, 9 points for 2nd etc. Competitors may enter multiple series and classes at each show, but must nominate at each show only one horse to gain points for rider series at each show. Competitors must attend the final show to be eligible for championship sashes but do not need to bring their horse if they are certain of their position. Please advise the secretary if you are attending final show without your horse to ensure placings are accurate.
9. **Brougham Orthopaedic Trust Child Rider Series** – is open to riders 14 years and under as of date of each show. Entry fee to be paid once for series and noted on each entry form. Points accumulate from one nominated horse ridden each day.
10. **Junior Rider Series** – is open to riders 15 years to 21 years as of date of each show. Entry fee to be paid once for series and noted on each entry form. Points accumulate from one nominated horse ridden each day.
11. **Amateur Rider Series** – is open to riders 22 years and over who have not competed above Level 3. Entry fee to be paid once for series and noted on each entry form. Points accumulate from one nominated horse ridden each day.
12. **Parking** - To ensure everybody can park on the grounds, **all parking will be allocated**. Ensure you state whether you have a truck or float & car, date arriving on the entry form. . To ensure all vehicles are able to park on the grounds and for the safety of competitors and spectators, **we have limited parking areas where horses and ponies are allowed to be kept at trucks or floats**. Ensure you book a yard or stable or request a tie-up parking space.
13. **Allocations** – All stabling, yarding, and parking will be allocated first to sponsors then on a first come-first served basis. Enter early to avoid disappointment.
14. **Scratchings:** Must be phoned to the secretary before or on show day – and then confirmed in writing accompanied by doctor/farrier/veterinary certificate within one week after event. We can either carry forward your entry fee less the show levy or refund to your bank account.
15. **Please check our website** www.tielceypark.co.nz from the Thurs before the show for draw; enclose SSAE if no access.
16. **Entries on official entry form only with all fees.** Entries without fees will be returned.
